GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE VICTIMS OF VIOLENT CRIMINAL ACTS

In accordance with the School Safety Choice Option stipulated in section 9532 of the No Child Left Behind Act a student who becomes a victim on a campus of one of the violent acts listed below is entitled to transfer to another grade appropriate campus.

- **Attempted murder** under Texas Penal Code Sections 19.02, 19.03, and 15.01 (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 17);
- **Indecency with a child** under Texas Penal Code Section 21.11 (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 18);
- **Aggravated kidnapping** under Texas Penal Code Section 20.04 (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 19)
- **Assault on student** under Texas Penal Code Section 22.01(a)(1) (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 28);
- **Aggravated assault on student** under Texas Penal Code Section 22.02 (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 30); and
- **Sexual assault or aggravated sexual assault against a student** under Texas Penal Code Sections 22.011 and 22.021 (reported under PEIMS 425 Action Reason Code 32).

Parents of students who are determined to be a victim of a violent criminal act in Kilgore ISD may apply to transfer the student immediately to any district that will accept them.

Kilgore ISD will cooperate fully with the receiving district by expediting the emission of student records to the student's new school. If the parents of the student desire to return their child to our district, the student will be placed at the appropriate grade level upon return.

All collection and maintenance of data relating to the incident will be the responsibility of the KISD Title IX Coordinator. This data will be used to assist in taking any corrective actions necessary to prevent future occurrences of violent criminal acts in Kilgore ISD.
