

## **RESUME OF MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES OCTOBER 25, 2010**

### **STUDENT RECOGNITION**

Fifth and seventh grade students in 2009-2010 were recognized for having achieved Commended Performance on the TAKS. Fifth grade students achieved Commended Performance on Reading, Mathematics, and Science; seventh grade students received Commended Performance on Reading, Mathematics, and Writing. Sixty-eight students were listed to receive the recognition.

### **WEBSITE FINANCIAL INFORMATION**

The Assistant Superintendent of Finance reviewed new financial information now listed on the Kilgore ISD website. Current and previous years' information is available in multiple areas.

### **CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY REPORT**

The Director of Technology/Career reported on Career and Technical Education: Achieve Texas Goals. Career Clusters and Programs of Study were discussed, personal graduation plans created for middle school, emphasis on college and career readiness, and integrating CTE with academic success. The program now involves much more than vocational studies and agriculture.

### **DUAL CREDIT**

The Superintendent reported on the increased participation of dual credit in Kilgore High School. In the Fall of 2009, KHS ranked third among area high schools in participation; ranking fifth in the Spring 2010.
