

## Senate Bill 9 Fingerprint Reject Notice

We have received notification that your fingerprints were rejected by the FBI fingerprinting system for one reason or another. You should have received a "Rejected FBI Fingerprint Record" email notice from TEA with a new FASTpass and instructions on making an appointment to be reprinted no sooner than 48 hours of receiving the notice. We have been told by a TEA fingerprint representative that if the directions in the email for having reprints processed are followed, there will not be any additional fees due.

Please call the L1 Enrollment Services telephone number listed in the email (888)467-2080 to schedule an appointment. They have appointments available from 8 to 5 Monday through Friday. The nearest L1 site from Kilgore is in Longview at Davis Insurance located near Texas Roadhouse at 414 E. Loop 281, Suite 21. **You will need to take the email notification, the new FAST pass that was attached to the rejection notice and your driver's license to your appointment.**

PLEASE NOTE: According to TEA, L1 is not authorized by the state to do any reprints during on-site visits. If you have already had your reprints taken on-site, chances are you will receive another rejection notice from TEA and will need to follow the instructions on the notice to be reprinted.

In closing, your campus principal has been notified that you will need to be promptly reprinted after the 48 hour waiting period at the Longview office. Please be sure to notify them ASAP of your scheduled appointment date and time so arrangements can be made to fill your position. **Upon returning to the district, please turn in a copy of the receipt issued to your campus office.**
