THREE TIERED CALENDAR:

TIER I: Regular School Year

WHEN: August 24, 2009—May 25, 2010

WHAT: Dismissed from School Seven Days Early

WHO: All Students who have successfully met all level requirements.

TIER II: Additional Instruction

WHEN: May 26, 2010—June 4, 2010

WHAT: 180 Days of Regular Instruction

WHO: Mandatory for students who fail any portion of the state assessment or fail to meet all grade level requirements.

TIER III: Summer Session

WHEN: June 8, 2010—July 8, 2010

WHAT: Summer School

WHO: Students working toward credit recovery.

Kilgore ISD's Optional Flexible Year Program (OFYP) is a unique initiative designed to ensure success for all students.

OFYP takes into account successful performance on the state assessment and provides an extended enrichment opportunity for students to benefit from small group and one-on-one instruction. The academic calendar will be comprised of three tiers for all students.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Compulsory attendance laws are in effect during Tier II and qualifying students **must attend entire seven days.**
