

## KHS Dual Credit

### Student Eligibility

A high school student is eligible to enroll in dual credit courses if the student meets the minimum passing standard on the TSI or meets one of the following exemptions:

ACT	Composite Score 23 with 19 in English and 19 in Math
SAT	480 Evidence Based Reading & Writing 530 in Math
EOC	English II- 4000 Alg 1- 4000

Students are enrolled in college courses by a KHS counselor. Dual credit courses fall under the guidelines of the college awarding the college credit. Students are responsible for meeting all deadlines set by Kilgore College. See attached dual credit contract for more information.

Students may enroll in online classes for early college credit as their schedule permits. Tuition for early college classes are not paid by KISD. Early college is for college credit only. Dual credit is for both college and high school credit.

### Texas Virtual School Network

TxVSN provides online courses to students in public school districts and open enrollment charter schools. The Texas Virtual School Network is a clearinghouse of rigorous online course offered by approved providers. Because the Texas Education Agency approves all courses, courses meet the state's high standards for teaching and learning. See a counselor for more information.

## Kilgore ISD Dual Credit Contract

The Dual Credit Program is a partnership between Kilgore ISD (KISD) and Kilgore College (KC). Dual credit courses are college level courses offered through Kilgore College and approved by Kilgore ISD. Dual credit courses provide opportunities for capable and highly motivated students to earn both high school credit and college hours at the same time. Dual credit is offered in both core academic and career/ technical (CTE) courses. KISD will pay dual credit tuition for qualifying students.

To qualify for the dual credit program, I understand I must meet college readiness standards and that my attendance, grades and discipline will be reviewed. Students involved in extra curricular activities should be aware of KC's attendance policy. If a student misses six or more classes for any reason, the student will be dropped from the course by KC.

I am requesting permission to take college course(s) for dual credit with Kilgore College. My parents and I agree to the following:

- I will return my registration form to counselors' office by the deadline.
- I will purchase appropriate textbook(s) and/or supplies needed for my course.
- I will attend class regularly and communicate with instructor should I miss class.
- I am limited to 2 dual credit classes per semester my junior year and 3 classes per semester my senior year.
- I must pass all my dual credit courses my junior year to be eligible to take 3 dual credit classes per semester my senior year.
- I understand that taking 3 dual credit classes my senior year, must be approved by the campus principal and high school counselor.
- I must receive a grade of 70 or better to receive high school credit for the course.
- I must receive a grade of 70 or better to continue having my dual credit classes paid for by KISD.
- If I fail a course with 69 or below, I will be responsible for reimbursing KISD for the cost of the course.
- If I drop a course after the 12<sup>th</sup> class day, I will be responsible for reimbursing KISD for the cost of the course.
- Students who live out of district may be responsible for reimbursing KISD for the difference in cost of tuition.
- Dual credit program policies and procedures are subject to change.
